POLICY NAME: PUBLIC ACCESS

TEXAS PROPERTY TAX CODE SEC. 6.04(d,e)

It is the policy of Delta County Appraisal District board of directors to provide the taxpayer with public access to the board.

In order to provide the public the opportunity to address the board, to inform the public of the board's duties, and to provide procedures for the resolution of complaints, the board grants a reasonable allotted time during each board meeting.

The agenda for each meeting shall include "Receipt of public comment". The time allotted is based on the number of speakers wishing to address the board.

The notice of meeting for the board of directors of Delta County Appraisal District shall be filed with the Delta County Clerks Office and posted in a place convenient to the public. Notices shall be posted 72 hours prior to each meeting. Public posting locations are the Delta County Appraisal District office and the Delta County Courthouse.

Any person wishing to address the board that does not speak English or communicates by sign language and is unable to provide an interpreter shall give written notice requesting assistance to the chief appraiser a minimum of 48 hours prior to the scheduled meeting. If possible, the chief appraiser will provide for interpretation.

Any person who has a physical, mental or developmental disability who wishes to address the board and that does not have the assistance to do so should notify the chief appraiser in writing a minimum of 48 hour prior to the scheduled meeting. If possible, the chief appraiser will provide for assistance.

The Delta County Appraisal District offices, where the board of directors meetings and the appraisal review board meetings are held, are wheelchair accessible and handicap parking is provided.
